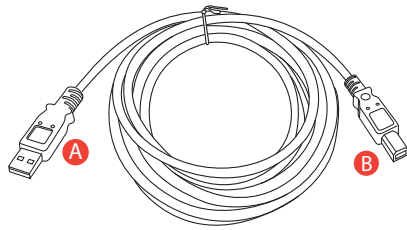

Multi-touch Screen and Laptop set-up

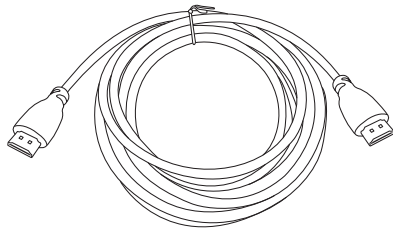
1. Cables

Supplied with your multi-touch screen are various 2 metre cables.

HDMI cable

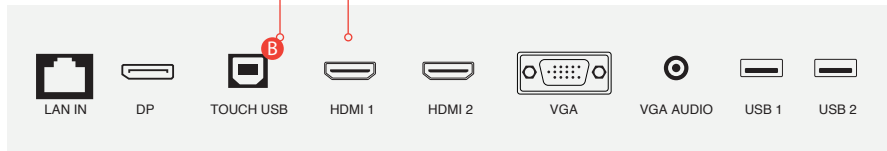
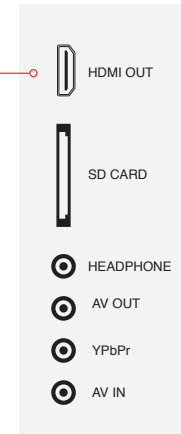


2. Rear panel

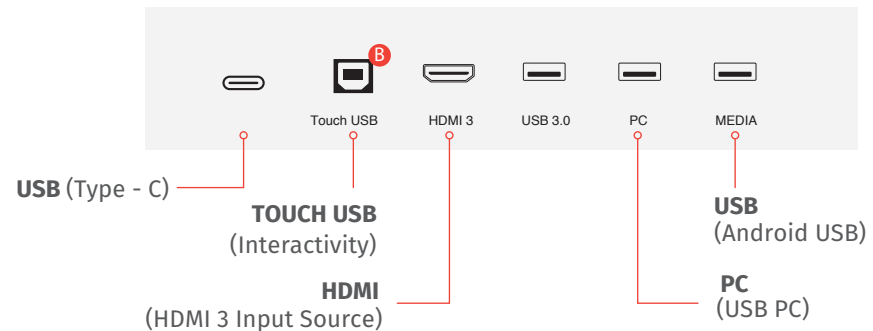
HDMI OUTPUT (Connect additional monitor)

TOUCH USB (Interactivity)

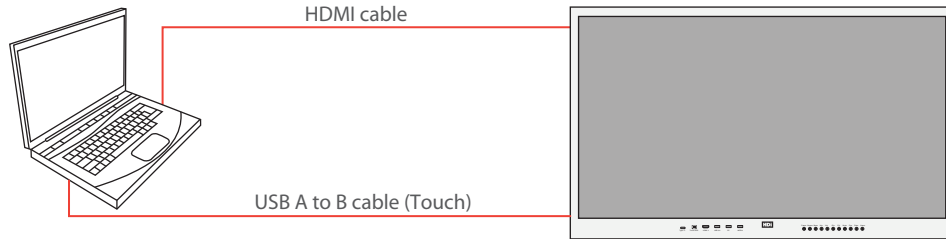


3. Front panel



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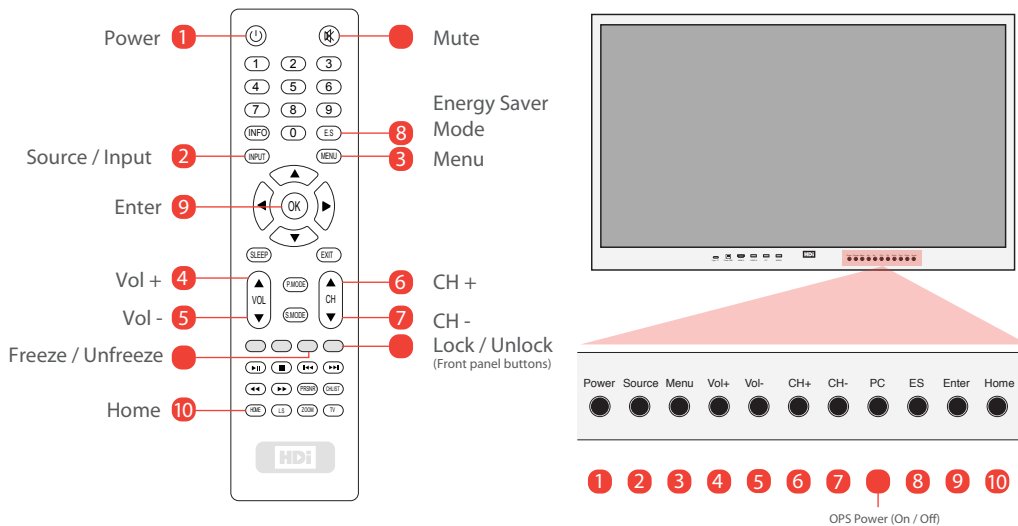
4. Connecting your Multi-touch-Screen and laptop



- Now that you are familiar with the cables, connect the B end of the USB A to B to the front / rear panel socket TOUCH USB. Then connect the A end to your laptop.
- If you are using HDMI, connect the cable to the front / rear panel HDMI socket and to your laptop.

5. Ready to use

You have now connected your multi-touch screen and laptop. Turn on your laptop and multi-touch screen. The multi-touch screen is now ready to use.



6. OSD

- 1 Click to open the left side bar
- 2 Annotation software
- 3 Go to all Android Apps
- 4 On screen user manual
- 5 Click to close the side bar
- 6 Click back home
- 7 Click to annotate
- 8 Quick access to OPS
- 9 Click to OSD menu
- 10 Click to change source
- 11 Click to reveal all open apps
- 12 Click to go back
